E. Nelson, Assistant Adjutant General, State of Minnesota, who is authorized according to law to exercise the powers of the Adjutant General during the existence of such incapacity, to be the officer authorized under Section 13, Sub-division (b), Chapter 332, Session Laws, State of Minnesota 1933, as amended, to act as a member and chairman of such commission and to exercise all the powers and duties vested in or imposed upon the Adjutant General as a member and chairman of such commission during the existence of such incapacity.
