

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 114, Mason's Minnesota Statutes 1927, and at the request of the Minnesota State Board of Optometry, do hereby constitute and appoint PETER E. KAMUCHEY of St. Paul, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General to act for the said Minnesota State Board of Optometry, and fix his compensation at \$300 per year and \$25 per day or \$12.50 per half-day for his attendance at Board meetings, fee for prosecutions to be subject to agreement between said Peter E. Kamuchey and the Minnesota State Board of Optometry. All compensation is to be paid from and out of the funds of the Board.

Said appointee shall serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General or until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law.
