P R O C L A M A T I O N

WHEREAS, the Government of the United States of America has entered into treaties with certain sister republics in this hemisphere for the improvement of radio broadcast reception, and,

WHEREAS, under such treaties certain radio broadcast frequencies must be reallocated among American radio broadcast stations on March 29, 1941, with Minnesota radio broadcast stations being assigned the following frequencies:
