


STATE OF MINNESOTA

OFFICE OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by law, and particularly by Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 114, and upon the request of L. E. Fiero, Director of the Division of Game and Fish of the Department of Conservation, do hereby constitute and appoint J. J. Hadler of International Falls, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General for the Division of Game and Fish to act as attorney for the defendants Arthur Emme, Ed. Pohrte and Clarence Cooke in actions pending in the District Court of Lake of the Woods County, Fifteenth Judicial District, State of Minnesota, and titled Fay Young, Plaintiff, vs. Emme, et al, Defendants, and Warroad Cooperative Creamery Association, Plaintiff, vs. Emme, et al, Defendants. Said appointment shall commence forthwith and shall continue until the final disposition of said actions, subject to termination otherwise at the pleasure of the Attorney General. The compensation for said services shall be at the rate of \$50.00 per day for actual trial work and \$25.00 per day for preparation therefor, and shall be paid by said Division of Game and Fish, Department of Conservation.


