NOW, THEREFORE, I, HAROLD G. HUSSEIN, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do
hereby designate and proclaim the month of April as

CANCER CONTROL MONTH

and I call upon the citizens of this state, the newspapers, radio stations
and other agencies to cooperate with the American Society for the Control of
Cancer in the educational program being conducted by them.
