

The Village Council of the Village of Marlstad do hereby
as follows:

That the following described lands, to-wit:
All of the Northwest Quarter of the Southeast Quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$),
except the Johnson tract, of Section Twentyfour (24),
Township 150 North, Range 40 West;

A tract in the southwest quarter of the northeast quarter
(SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said section 24, described as follows:
Beginning at the southeast corner of said forty acre tract
and running west along the south line of said tract a distance
of 1000 feet, thence north at right angles to said line a
distance of forty rods, thence east a distance of 1000 feet,
thence south along the east line of said tract a distance of
40 rods to the point of beginning;

All of the north half of the southwest quarter of the
northeast quarter of said section 24, which lies west of
the Soo Line Right-of-way; which adjoins and abuts upon
the incorporated village of Marlstad, be and the same are hereby
annexed to said village and shall become a part of said
village as effectually as if they had been originally a
part thereof.
