

RESOLUTION OF THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF THE RIVER.

It appearing that on the 28th day of December, 1910 a petition of over fifty resident voters of the Village of The River having filed with the recorder of said Village praying that a special election be called for the purpose of reincorporating said Village in the general law, pursuant to chapter 9 of the revised laws of Minnesota for the year 1905, and all acts and parts of said supplementary thereto; and it further appearing that from the affidavit that at least ten days' notice and one week published notice of said special election had been duly given, and the common council of the Village of The River having designated the 28th day of January, 1911 for the holding of said special election; and it appearing further that at said election as held there were 123 votes for reincorporation and 7 votes against it, and it appearing that a majority for said reincorporation had been duly voted by the voters of said Village.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that we, the common council of the Village of The River hereby declare that a majority of all the votes cast at said election were cast in favor of such reincorporation; and that the said Village of The River is now duly reincorporated under said chapter 9, and all acts and parts of said supplementary thereto, returned to the statutes in such form made and provided.
