P R O C L A M A T I O N

WHEREAS, this year the people of the State of Minnesota are being honored by the opportunity to act as hosts to the Ninth National Eucharistic Congress, and,

WHEREAS, as one of the closing features on the program a procession comprised of tens of thousands of people from the parishes, schools and societies of the Archdiocese of St. Paul, supplemented by delegations from all over the country, will be held, and,

WHEREAS, many of our citizens will be desirous of participating in or viewing this procession,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold E. Stassen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby designate and proclaim June 26, 1941 beginning at 12:00 o'clock noon a state holiday, and urge all governmental subdivisions, schools and business concerns to cooperate by closing during this period.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul this 26 day of June, 1941.
