

P R O C L A M A T I O N

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold E. Stassen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, June 15, 1941 as

in the State of Minnesota and urge that we citizens of Minnesota on this day make a special effort to honor our fathers.
