PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, dairying, representing nearly one hundred million dollars of the wealth of the State, is Minnesota's greatest industry, and,

WHEREAS, science has long recognized the important part played by dairy products in sustaining a healthful diet for adults of all ages as well as children, and,

WHEREAS, June being a season of plenty on the farms of this State, with a downward trend in prices resulting, milk is now among the most economical food purchases for any family, and,

WHEREAS, all of the people of Minnesota are thus vitally concerned either directly or indirectly in the vast agricultural industry.

Now, therefore, I, Harold E. Stassen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby designate and proclaim the period from

June 1 to July 1, 1941

as

MILK MONTH

and urge that all of our people take advantage of this opportunity to use and enjoy more milk, cream, ice cream, butter, cheese and other dairy products to "Make America Strong by Making Americans Stronger" as well as to
