P R O C L A M A T I O N

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold H. Stassen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do call you, each and everyone, to your observance of U. S. C. Sabbath with those of your own particular creed.

Let us on that day reaffirm our faith in the infinite mercy and justice of God, and give thanks to Him for the many blessings He has bestowed upon us. And let us pray, too, each in his own heart but with common voice, for the safety and well-being of those in the service of our country.
