PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, our democracy needs all men for the fight against dictatorship,
and

WHEREAS, unity and co-ordination develop the manpower which makes our
country strong, and

WHEREAS, a program to eliminate discrimination in defense employment
is being sponsored by defense councils, civic organizations, labor groups, schools,
and colleges,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold E. Stassen, Governor of the State of Minnesota,
do hereby proclaim

DEC. 5TH, 6TH, AND 7TH, 1941

AS DAYS OF

"NATIONAL UNIFORMITY THROUGH DEMOCRATIC EMPLOYMENT PRACTICE"

and I urge the people of the State to co-operate with these organizations in their
effort to employ all workers on the basis of their ability, without regard to race,
color, creed or national origin.
