WHEREAS, the year 1941 marks the one hundred and fiftieth anniversary of the ratification of the Bill of Rights, which vouchsafes to us the freedom basic to our American form of Democracy, and

WHEREAS, when we look out today upon a world where Freedom and Justice have perished from many lands, we are deeply grateful to the founding fathers of this mighty republic, and mindful of their devotion to the cause of Liberty and Democracy, and

WHEREAS, there has been passed by the Congress of the United States and approved by the President, a Joint resolution to provide for the proper observance of this important anniversary,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold B. Stassen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do proclaim the week of


