

CERTIFICATE OF CITY CHARTER AMENDMENT

I, Earl W. Bucklen, in my capacity as the duly elected, qualified and acting Mayor of the City of Bemidji, Beltrami County, Minnesota, do hereby certify that at a special election held in and for said City of Bemidji on December 10, 1941, the hereto attached amendment to the City Charter of said City was duly adopted and approved by the affirmative vote of more than sixty per cent of all the voters voting at said election; and that said election was duly held in conformity with all the provisions of the Constitution and Statutes of the State of Minnesota applicable thereto.

#### AMENDMENT

Sections 24, 25 and 26 of Chapter III of the City Charter of the City of Bemidji adopted on September 26th, 1905, are hereby amended to read as follows:

#### ASSESSOR

SECTION 24. The City Council upon the adoption of this amendment and thereafter at its first regular meeting in August of each even numbered year, shall appoint an Assessor for the City of Bemidji. The salary of said Assessor shall be set by the City Council prior to the making of each such appointment. The Council may at any time in its discretion appoint a Deputy Assessor or Deputy Assessors and shall before the appointment of such Deputy or Deputies set the salary for each such deputy. The City Council may by ordinance establish rules, regulations and qualifications for the office of City Assessor.

SECTION 25. The Assessor and his deputies shall qualify in the manner and form prescribed for them by the general law and shall perform all the duties required by the general laws of the State of Minnesota.

SECTION 26. This amendment shall take effect immediately upon its approval by the electors of the City of Bemidji and shall supersede any provisions of the City Charter inconsistent herewith.
