


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, J. A. A. Burnquist, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by law, and particularly by Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 114, and upon the request of L. E. Fiero, Director of the Division of Game and Fish of the Department of Conservation, do hereby constitute and appoint Clarence R. Smith of Bemidji, Minnesota, as Special Assistant Attorney General for the Division of Game and Fish to prosecute on behalf of the State of Minnesota, an action in ejectment against Boleslaw Znajda. Said appointment shall commence forthwith and continue until the final disposition of said action, subject to termination otherwise at the pleasure of the Attorney General. The compensation for said services shall be paid by the said Division of Game and Fish, Department of Conservation.
