The following is a resolution adopted by the County Board at their meeting held on the 8th day of January 1942:

The petition filed by Wm. Kitchenmaster, Sr. and twenty-seven other signatures asked the County Board to fix a date, time, place and appoint three election judges for the election to be held in the Village of Steen for the purpose of voting on the question as to whether or not the Village shall be incorporated. On motion Tuesday, February 3, 1942, between the hours of 1 and 7 p.m. and in the town hall in the Village of Steen, was fixed as the time and place for said election; and A. C. Ridenour, Wm. Kitchenmaster and Ed Van Den Heuvel were appointed as inspectors or election judges to preside on the above date.

To the Honorable Board of County Commissioners of Rock County, State of Minnesota

The undersigned, your petitioners, respectfully show that they are each and all electors and legal voters now actually residing upon the lands hereinafter described and proposed to be incorporated; and they respectfully petition your Honorable Body to appoint a time and place when and where the electors actually residing upon said lands hereinafter describéd may vote for or against the incorporation of said lands as a village under the laws of this state.

Said territory proposed to be incorporated and the boundaries thereof with their courses and distances as follows:

Beginning at a point on the Section Line, between Sections Twenty Nine and Thirty Two, in Township One Hundred and One, North, Range Forty Five, west of the Fifth Principal Meridian, in Rock County, Minnesota, easterly one hundred and twenty rods from the north and south Quarter Line of said Section; thence northerly eighty rods, parallell with said Quarter Line of said Section; thence westerly two hundred and fifty rods, parallel with esid Section Line; then southerly one hundred and eighty rods, parallel with said Quarter Lines; thence easterly, two hundred and fifty rods, parallel with said Section Line; thence northerly one hundred rods to the point of beginning; containing one hundred eighty one and twenty five hundredth acres, (281.25), including the I.C.R.R.
