

WHEREAS, the Children's Bureau, Washington, D. C. has offered to make a gift or grant of \$3,649.00 through the Bureau for Crippled Children for the following purposes and upon the following conditions:

First, the grant of \$3,649.00 shall be paid to the State of Minnesota in installments of \$2,000.00 on or before March 31, 1942, and \$1,649.00 on or before June 30, 1942.

Second, that said grant shall be used by the State of Minnesota for making braces and special appliances for children under the care of the Gillette State Hospital for Crippled Children, the work to be done in the Special Appliance Shop at the Hospital for Crippled Children.

Third, that a complete statement of disbursements from said grant shall be transmitted to the Division of Social Welfare, Bureau for Crippled Children.






