


DEPARTMENT OF CONSERVATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, W. L. Strunk, Commissioner of Conservation of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of authority vested in me by law, and particularly by Laws 1937, Chapter 310, and Laws 1941, Chapter 120, Section 4, do hereby constitute and appoint Verne E. Joslin of Heron Lake, Minnesota, as acting incumbent of the office of Director of the Division of Game and Fish. Said appointment shall commence on March 16, 1942, or as soon thereafter as such acting incumbent shall have qualified, and continue during the absence of L. E. Fiero, now on leave of absence for the purpose of active service in the military forces of the United States, subject to termination otherwise at the will of the Commissioner of Conservation.
