PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, one of the most important civic duties of the people of Minnesota is the promotion of temperance and sobriety, and,

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the churches, civic groups and other agencies interested in the social welfare of our people should unite in a program of education sponsoring clean living and the building of physical well-being,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold E. Stassen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim and designate

Sunday, May 17, 1942

as

TEMPERANCE SUNDAY

and urge all the people of Minnesota to devote a portion of that day to the promotion of temperance and sobriety.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in St. Paul this 24th day of March, 1942.
