WHEREAS, Senate Concurrent Resolution 5, passed in the First Session of the Seventy-fifth Congress of the United States of America, provided that April 6th of each year be recognized as "Army Day", and

WHEREAS, the history of our Army has been a series of heroic accomplishments, and

WHEREAS, from the beginning of our nation to the present time, our Army has been a bulwark of protection against foreign aggression and a guardian of our democratic institutions,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold E. Stassen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim and designate

April 6, 1942

as

ARMY DAY

and urge the people of Minnesota to devote a portion of this day to a proper observance thereof and to display the American flag on homes and other buildings.
