PROCLAMATION  
GOVERNOR'S CHILD HEALTH DAY MESSAGE

WHEREAS, the importance of the health of children to the strength of the nation is recognized and a national effort to have all children over nine months of age immunized against small pox and diphtheria is essential, and

WHEREAS, in our State, since November 1941, the Minnesota State Medical Association and Minnesota Department of Health, with the cooperation of schools and local health, civil defense and civic agencies, have, as a war preparedness activity, sponsored a state-wide campaign of vaccination against smallpox and immunization against diphtheria,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold E. Stassen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim and designate

May 1, 1942

as

CHILD HEALTH DAY

and urge all people to co-operate with their physicians, and
