Dear Sir:-

This is to certify that on November 21st, 1910 the Village of Cuyuna in said County of Crow Wing held a special election to vote on the proposition as to whether the village should become a separate election and assessment district.

The vote stood twenty-nine votes in favor of separation, and none against separation. The proposition was therefore declared duly passed.

N $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$ section 1, Twp 46, Rge 29,
Fractional east half of section 36, Twp 47, Rge 29.
