AMENDMENT TO SECTION 30 OF CHAPTER IV OF CITY CHARTER OF WEST ST.PAUL, MINNESOTA

That Section 30, Ohapter 4, of the existing charter of the City of West St.Paul be amended, and when so amended shall read as follows:-

The Common Council shall not have the power or authority to relieve any person or corporation from the payment of any lawful tax, assessment, fine or license, or to exempt him from any burden imposed upon him or it by law or order, or ordain the payment of any demand not authorized and audited according to law.

Provided, however, that this section shall not be construed as preventing or limiting the power of the Common Council of the City of West St.Paul, to prescribe that all certificates of sales for local improvements, or other improvements, now held by the City of West St.Paul, in any manner, and upon which the time for redemption has not yet expired, upon the expiration of the time aforesaid, may be sold by said City by public sale or sales, by and through such officer or officers at such times upon such public notice and upon such terms and conditions as is by ordinance determined by said Common Council of the City of West St.Paul.
