WHEREAS, It is the duty as well as the privilege of every citizen of Minnesota to support the war by investing in War Bonds and Stamps; and

WHEREAS, a quota has been set for the State and its Counties by the Honorable Henry Morgenthau, Jr., Secretary of the Treasury, and

WHEREAS, To do our full share, we should buy War Bonds in ever increasing number, and every person should strive to set aside ten percent of his income for this purpose;

THEREFORE, I, Harold E. Stassen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim


May 1, 1942
