PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Slavic people of Europe are beset by war and aggression; and

WHEREAS, the Slavic American peoples of this nation have shown unity and singleness of purpose in striving with America for victory in its war against aggressors; and

WHEREAS, these same Slavic groups have contributed greatly to the cultural and economic welfare of America,

NOW THEREFORE, I, HAROLD E. STASSEN,
Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby designate and proclaim

Sunday, June 21, 1942

as

AMERICAN SLAV DAY

and I do urge that the people of the State recognize and encourage this cultural contribution and demonstration of unity by the Slavic Americans.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in Saint Paul, this 29th day of May, 1942.
