

WHEREAS, Minnesota is to be honored on Saturday, June 20th, by the visit of a delegation of American and British heroes, including a worthy son of Minnesota, who have won fame in the present War, and

WHEREAS, it is fitting that Minnesota should pay due tribute to these men who are fighting to preserve our liberties, and

WHEREAS, all citizens should gather in great demonstrations to acclaim these heroes for their deeds and for the cause they represent, and
