

Minutes of Canvassing Board - Special Election

We the undersigned Judges of special election for the detachment of certain lands from the village of Graceville, find that a majority of the voters cast on the ^{8th day of June, 1942, in the village of Graceville, were in favor of detaching the lands hereinafter described from said village, and we further certify and show there were a total of 55 votes cast, and of those, 52 votes were for detaching said lands from said village, and 3 votes were against the proposition of detaching said lands from said village, which lands are described as follows:}

Outlots Twenty-nine and Thirty (29 & 30)
Village of Graceville, County of Big Stone,
State of Minnesota.

We further certify and show that we will cause this certificate to be recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds for and in Big Stone County within ten days after said election, and in the office of the Secretary of State within ten days after said election.
