58 voters of the Village of Belgrade, and the Township of
Crow River praying that the following question be submitted
to the voters at the Annual Township Election to be held on
March 11, 1941, as follows: "Shall the Township of Crow River
separate from the Village of Belgrade to form a separate and
independent Voting District for all time and purposes."
