WHEREAS, fire exacts an appalling toll in life and property damage each year in the State of Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, it is urgent that all citizens of the State give thought to the need of greater precaution in preventing such wasteful destruction of property and the resultant tragic loss of life, and

WHEREAS, due to present world conditions fire defense is vital to national defense,

NOW THEREFORE, I, Harold E. Stassen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of


October 4th to 10th, 1942

as


FIRE PREVENTION WEEK

and I further urge that during this week the people of the state, through the medium of our schools and civic organizations, give particular attention to the promotion of fire prevention and the resultant saving of lives and property.
