



BURNQUIST, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of §8.06, Minnesota Statutes 1941 (being §114, Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927), do hereby constitute and appoint WM. T. JOHNSON of Stillwater, Minnesota, as special assistant attorney general for the purpose of assisting in the prosecution of the revocation of veterinary licenses of certain veterinarians, and in the conduct of any and all proceedings in connection therewith, whether instituted by the State Veterinary Examining Board or by the State of Minnesota in behalf of said board, or by the defendant. 
