PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, American Education Week grew out of the first World War examinations disclosing twenty-five percent of the men were illiterate and twenty percent were physically unfit, and

WHEREAS, a campaign of public information and a long-range program for the extension of education to correct those findings was instituted at the behest of the American Legion in collaboration with the national educators in 1921, and the present American Education Week conceived,

NOW, THEREFORE, to direct the attention of our citizens to the necessity of perpetuating this educational program, I, Harold E. Stassen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim

as


AMERICAN EDUCATION WEEK
