WE, MIKE HOLM, SECRETARY OF STATE, Harry M. Gallagher, CHIEF JUSTICE OF THE SUPREME COURT, Harry H. Peterson, ASSOCIATE JUSTICE OF THE SUPREME COURT, John W. Baerner, JUDGE OF THE DISTRICT COURT, SECOND JUDICIAL DISTRICT, AND Arthur W. 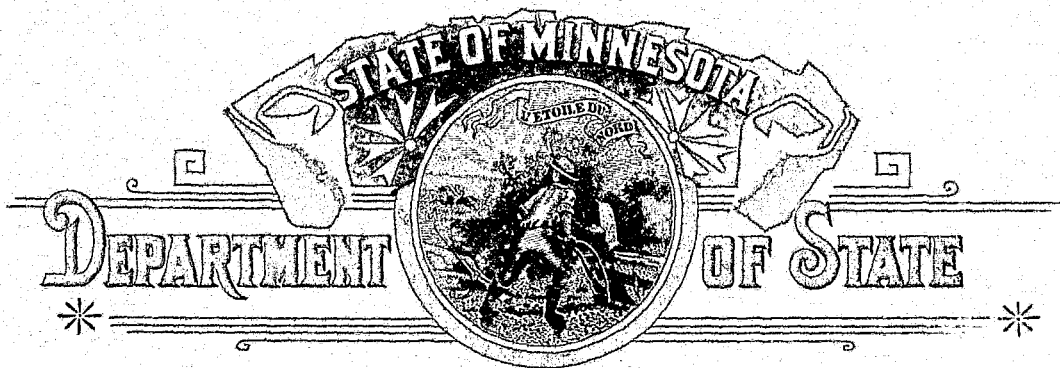
