WHEREAS, the seventh day of December bears the sear of the infamous Japanese attack at Pearl Harbor, and

WHEREAS, it is our solemn resolve to perpetuate those inalienable rights for them, and for us, and for our children,

NOW THEREFORE, I, HAROLD E. STASSEN Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim

DECEMBER 7, 1942

as

PEARL HARBOR DAY

and dedicate it to an absolute victory in this terrible war and to the winning of an everlasting peace for all.
