Olson, Director of the Division of Water Resources and Engineering, and of the Commissioner of Conservation, do hereby constitute and appoint C. D. O'Brien III of St. Paul, Minnesota, as Special Counsel for the Division of Water Resources and Engineering of the Department of Conservation and for the Department of Conservation, to render legel services to such state agencies. Said appointment shall commence on January 4, 1943, and shall continue until terminated by law or at the pleasure of the Attorney General.
