N O W T H E R E F O R E , I , HAROLD E. STANBEN, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby join with our Commander-in-Chief, and do hereby proclaim

TUESDAY, JANUARY 12, 1943,

FARM MOBILIZATION DAY

and ask that on that day the farmers of Minnesota gather with the United States Department of Agriculture War Board representatives and others concerned, in order to discuss ways and means of insuring for the year 1943 the maximum production of vital foods
