**PROCLAMATION**

WHEREAS, the armed forces of the United States are desperately in need of non-ferreous metals, and

WHEREAS, our government has issued an urgent call for scrap collections of brass, bronze, and copper with the utmost expediency, and

WHEREAS, the school children of the State of Minnesota in their intense patriotism have always rallied to a call from their country, and

WHEREAS, the War Production Board and the War Activities Committee of the motion picture industries have united to stage copper scrap matinees in all northwest theatres the week starting February 5th, 1943,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, HAROLD E. STASSEN, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim

February 5th to 12th

as

Copper Scrap Week

and urge the school children of Minnesota to unite in this important war effort.
