
Dear Sir:

We wish to advise you that in the past few months a number of notices regarding estate matters have reached this Department. Inasmuch as the notices have in the past been addressed by your good offices to the former German Embassy, they are automatically turned over to the Censor. They are then sent to White Sulphur Springs, where the German diplomatic group is detained, and thus the notices reach us with a delay of about two months.

Switzerland, as you are aware, has been designated as Protecting Power for German interests in the United States.
