## REMEMBER...

That your registration as Architect, Professional Engineer, or Land Surveyor expires December 31, 1943. This date and the amount due are specified by law, and the Board has no authority to make any change. If your renewal fee is not received at the office of the Board on or before December 31, 1943, your name cannot be included in the Roster of Registrants authorized to practice your profession in 1944.

The renewal fee and penalty, if paid after December 31, 1943, is

\$5.00 for an Architect or an Engineer

2.00 for a Land Surveyor

5.00 is the aggregate fee for renewal in any two or three of the professions.

See last paragraph of Sec. 9 of the Act and the Board's Rules and Regulations—paragraph 4 Fees (h).

Many of the Registrants have been registered several years and have never changed or revised their records of education or experience since their original applications were filed. This Board receives inquiries from State and National agencies from time to time relative to some of the Registrants. It is the desire of the Board to serve the interests of Registrants by giving to these inquirers full and adequate replies, and for this reason current information from the Registrants is requested. This may be given by letter, which should contain a complete record of education and experience from date of the original application to the present time, as follows:

(Dates of all engagements should be given in chronological order)

Outline of the work done in each engagement with a statement of Registrant's responsibility relative to executed projects, and a description of the important details thereof.

Names of employers or of superiors in each case

and

Names of responsible references who have personal knowledge of Registrant's work and character.

CHAPTER 523, LAWS OF 1921

AS AMENDED BY CHAPTER 404, LAWS OF 1933

An act to regulate the practice of architecture, professional engineering and land surveying.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Architects, Engineers and Surveyors to be Registered.—In order to safeguard life, health and property, any person practicing or offering to practice as an architect, a professional engineer or land surveyor in this State shall hereafter be required to submit evidence that he is qualified so to practice, and shall be registered as hereinafter provided; and from and after six months after this Act becomes effective, it shall be unlawful for any person to practice or to offer to practice in this State as an architect, a professional engineer (hereinafter called engineer) or a land surveyor except under the provisions of this Act. No person shall practice or offer to practice as an architect, engineer or land surveyor, nor accept employment for compensation, in responsible charge of the preparation of plans and specifications for building, engineering or surveying work in this State unless he shall have registered under the terms of this Act, except that the provisions of this Act shall not apply to practice with regard to any single family or two family dwelling nor to any farm dwelling or building accessory thereto, nor to any building work the total cost of which does not exceed \$7,500, nor to the erection, enlargement or alteration of any building or structure, by any person, firm or corporation, or the employees thereof, exclusively for his or its own occupancy and/or use, nor to any building or the plans or specifications therefor when such plans and specifications are prepared by an established contractor or builder in negotiating for employment as such or in detailing his proposal to or agreement with a person for whom he proposes to build as a contractor or builder or for use in obtaining a building permit in connection with such constructing or building work and that the same are signed by the authors thereof with a true statement of their relation to such construction and not as architects or engineers.

Sec. 2. Public Works—Registrants only to Design and Supervise—Elective Office Holders Exempted.

No person shall represent himself as, or use the title of, "Registered Architect," "Registered Professional Engineer" or "Registered Land Surveyor," unless such person is qualified by registration under this Act.

No person, except an architect, engineer or land surveyor registered as provided for in this act, shall be employed in responsible charge of the preparation of plans or specifications for any public work or public improvement in this state or in responsible charge or supervision of architectural, engineering or land surveying for any public work or public improvement in this state.

No plat, map or drawing of any survey or subdivision of lands required by law to be filed or recorded with the Register of Deeds or registered with the Registrar of Titles of any county, shall be filed, recorded or registered therein unless there shall be endorsed thereon a certificate by a registered land surveyor.

The provisions hereof shall not apply to any person holding an elective office when in discharging the duties thereof such person is required to do work or perform service of the character of work or service usually done or performed by an architect, engineer or land surveyor.

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**Sec. 3. State Board Created—Terms—Appointment.**—To carry out the provisions of this act there is hereby created a State Board of Registration for architects, engineers and land surveyors (hereinafter called the Board) consisting of seven members, who shall be appointed by the Governor within sixty days after this act becomes effective. Three members shall be registered architects, three members shall be registered engineers and one member shall be a registered land surveyor. Not more than one member of said Board shall be from the same branch of the profession of engineering. The members of the first Board shall be appointed to serve for the following terms: two members for one year; two members for two years; two members for three years; and one member for four years, said terms ending on the first day of January of the succeeding years. On the expiration of each of said terms the term of office of each newly appointed or reappointed member of the Board shall be for a period of four years and shall terminate on the first day of January; except that each member shall hold over after the expiration of his term until his successor shall have been duly appointed and qualified. The Governor may remove any member of the Board for misconduct, incompetency or neglect of duty. Vacancies in the membership of the Board, however created, shall be filled by appointment by the Governor for the unexpired term.

**Sec. 4. Qualifications of Members of Board.**—Each member of the Board shall be a citizen of the United States and a resident of this State at the time of his appointment. He shall have been engaged in the practice of his profession for at least ten years and shall have been in responsible charge of work for at least five years. He shall be a member in good standing of a recognized society of architects, engineers or land surveyors, and except as provided in Section 5, shall be a registered architect, registered engineer or registered land surveyor.

**Sec. 5. Powers and Duties of the Board.**—Each member of the Board shall receive a certificate of appointment from the Governor, and before beginning his term of office he shall file with the Secretary of State the constitutional oath of office. Each member of the Board first created shall receive a certificate of registration under this act from the Governor of this State. The Board or any committee thereof shall be entitled to the services of the Attorney General in connection with the affairs of the Board, and the Board shall have power to compel the attendance of witnesses, may administer oaths and may take testimony and proofs concerning all matters within its jurisdiction. The Board shall adopt and have an official seal which shall be affixed to all certificates of registration granted; and shall make all by-laws and rules, not inconsistent with law needed in performing its duties; and shall fix standards for determining the qualifications of applicants for certificates, which shall not exceed the requirements contained in the curriculum of a recognized school of architecture or engineering.

**Sec. 6. Meetings—Officers—Quorum.**—The Board shall hold a meeting within thirty days after its members are first appointed, and thereafter shall hold at least two regular meetings each year. Special meetings shall be held at such times as the by-laws of the Board may provide. Notice of all meetings shall be given in such manner as the by-laws may provide. The Board shall elect annually from its members a chairman, a vice-chairman and a secretary-treasurer. A quorum of the Board shall consist of not less than four members, of whom two shall be architects and two engineers.

**Sec. 7. Fees to be Used for Expenses—Compensation of Members—Bonds of Officers.**—All fees and other monies accruing from the operation of this act shall be paid to the Board and shall be used for the purposes of this act. The expenses of the Board shall be paid by voucher made by the secretary-treasurer and approved by the chairman. Each member of the Board shall receive such compensation as the Board may direct, not to

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exceed \$10.00 per day for time spent in attending meetings of the Board. The members of the Board shall be reimbursed for actual expenses incurred in travel to and from meetings and for expenditures for hotel bills, meals, stationery, postage, printing, typewriting and the like necessary expenses incurred in the performance of their duties under this act. The secretary-treasurer of the Board shall give a surety bond satisfactory to the State Treasurer conditioned upon the faithful performance of his duties. The premium on said bond shall be regarded as a proper and necessary expense of the Board.

**Sec. 8. Records—Reports—Rosters.**—The Board shall keep a record of its proceedings and a register of all applicants for registration showing for each, the date of application, name, age, educational and other qualifications, place of business and place of residence, whether or not an examination was required and whether the applicant was rejected or a certificate of registration granted, and the date of such action. The books and register of the Board shall be prima facie evidence of all matters recorded therein. A roster showing the names and places of business and of residence of all registered architects, engineers and land surveyors shall be prepared by the secretary-treasurer of the Board during the month of January of each year; such roster shall be printed out of the funds of the Board as provided in Section 7. On or before the first day of February of each year the Board shall submit to the Governor and file with the Secretary of State a copy of the report of its transactions for the preceding year together with a complete statement of the receipts and expenditures of the Board signed by the chairman and the secretary-treasurer, accompanied by a certified audit, and a copy of the said roster of registered architects, registered engineers and registered land surveyors.

**Sec. 9. Applications—Qualifications—Certificates—Expirations—Renewals—Fees.**—The Board shall, on application therefor, on prescribed form and the payment of a fee of not to exceed Ten Dollars (\$10.00) issue a certificate of registration as an architect or an engineer, and on the payment of a fee of not to exceed Five Dollars (\$5.00) issue a certificate of registration as a land surveyor;

1. To any person over twenty-five (25) years of age, who is a citizen of the United States or Canada, or who has made declaration of his intention to become a citizen of the United States; who speaks and writes the English language; who is of good moral character and repute, and has been actively engaged either as an employer or an employee for five or more years in the practice of architecture or engineering, or engaged for four or more years in surveying work. The character of such practice or work shall be equal to the standards fixed by the Board. Each year of teaching or of study satisfactorily completed, of architecture, engineering or surveying in a school of architecture or engineering of a standard recognized by the Board, shall be considered as equivalent to one year of such active engagement.

2. To any person who holds a like unexpired certificate of registration issued to him by proper authority in the District of Columbia, in any state or territory of the United States, or in any province of Canada, in which the requirements for registration of architects, engineers or land surveyors are equal to those fixed by the Board for this State, and in which similar privileges are extended to the holders of certificates of registration issued by this State.

3. To any person who prior to the passage of this Act resided in this State and practiced as an architect, engineer or as a land surveyor.

When the evidence presented by an applicant for a certificate of registration shall not be conclusive or convincing as warranting the issuance of

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a certificate, the Board may require further evidence to be presented, or may, subject to such examination as may be deemed necessary to establish his qualifications.

In determining the qualifications in such cases of applicants for registration as architects, a majority vote of the architect members of the Board only shall be required; in determining the qualifications in such cases of applicants for registration as engineers a majority vote of the engineer members of the Board only, shall be required; and in determining the qualifications of applicants for registration as land surveyors the affirmative vote of the land surveyor member and of one engineer of the Board only, shall be required.

The Board may make reasonable rules and regulations for classifying and registering engineers in divisions according to their qualifications to practice different classes of engineering work and shall, in such case, register qualified applicants in one or more such divisions in which they shall qualify under the terms of this act and shall, in any event, provide one such division for highway engineers.

Any person so qualified may be registered in two or all of the three professions covered by this Act; but the aggregate fee for such registration shall not exceed Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars.

In case the Board denies the issuance of a certificate to an applicant, the registration fee deposited shall be returned by the Board to the applicant.

Certificates of registration shall expire on the last day of the calendar year for which they are issued and shall become invalid on that date unless renewed. It shall be the duty of the secretary-treasurer of the Board to notify, by mail, every person registered hereunder of the date of the expiration of his certificate and the amount of the fee required for its renewal for one year; such notice shall be mailed at least one month in advance of the date of the expiration of said certificate. Renewal may be effected at any time during the month of December by the payment of a fee of Three (\$3.00) Dollars for an architect or an engineer, and One (\$1.00) Dollar for a land surveyor.

The failure on the part of any registrant to renew his certificate annually in the month of December as required above shall not deprive such person of his right of renewal thereafter, but the fees to be paid for the renewal of the certificate after the succeeding first day of January shall be Five (\$5.00) Dollars for an architect or an engineer, and Two (\$2.00) Dollars for a land surveyor. The aggregate fee for renewal of registration in two or three of the professions shall be the same as the single renewal fee for registration as an architect or an engineer.

**Sec. 10. Revocation and Reissue of Certificates—Charges against Registrants—Hearings.**—The Board shall have the power to revoke the certificate of registration of any architect, engineer or land surveyor registered hereunder, who is found guilty of any fraud or deceit in obtaining a certificate of registration or of gross negligence, incompetency or misconduct in the practice of architecture, engineering or land surveying. Any person may prefer charges of such fraud, deceit, negligence, incompetency or misconduct against any architect, engineer or land surveyor registered hereunder. Such charges shall be in writing, sworn to by the complainant and submitted to the Board; and unless dismissed without hearing by the Board as unfounded or trivial, shall be heard and determined by the Board within three months after the date on which they are preferred. A time and place for such hearing, shall be fixed by the Board. A copy of the charges, together with a notice of the time and place of hearing, shall be legally

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served on the accused at least thirty days before the date fixed for the hearing, and in the event that such service can not be effected thirty days before the hearing, then the date of hearing and determination shall be postponed as may be necessary to permit the carrying out of this condition. At said hearing the accused shall have the right to appear personally and by counsel, to cross-examine witnesses against him and to produce evidence and witnesses in his defense. If after said hearing five or more members of the Board vote in favor of finding the accused guilty of any fraud or deceit in obtaining a certificate, or of gross negligence, incompetency or misconduct in the practice of architecture, engineering or land surveying, the Board shall revoke the certificate of registration of the accused.

The Board may reissue a certificate of registration to any person whose certificate has been revoked, provided five or more members of the Board vote in favor of such reissuance for reasons the Board may deem sufficient.

A new certificate of registration to replace any certificate revoked, lost, destroyed or mutilated, may be issued, subject to the rules and regulations of the Board. A charge of one dollar shall be made for such reissuance.

**Sec. 11. Evidence of Registration—Seals.**—The issuance of a certificate of registration by this Board shall be evidence that the person named therein is entitled to all rights and privileges of a registered architect, registered engineer or registered land surveyor while the said certificate remains unrevoked or unexpired.

Each registrant hereunder may upon registration obtain a seal of the design authorized by the Board, bearing the registrant's name and the legend "Registered Architect," "Registered Professional Engineer" or "Registered Land Surveyor." Plans, specifications, plats, reports or other documents issued by a registrant may be stamped with said seal during the life of registrant's certificate, but it shall be unlawful for anyone to stamp or seal documents with said seal after the certificate of the registrant named thereon has expired or has been revoked.

**Sec. 12. Violations—Penalties.**—Any person who is not authorized to practice in this State as an architect, an engineer or a land surveyor under the provisions of this Act and shall so practice, or offer so to practice, and any person presenting or attempting to file as his own the certificate of registration of another, or who shall give false or forged evidence of any kind to the Board, or to any member thereof, for the purpose of obtaining a certificate of registration, or who shall falsely impersonate any other practitioner, of like or different name, or who shall use or attempt to use an expired or revoked certificate of registration, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.

**Sec. 13. Exemptions.**—The following shall be exempted from the provisions of this Act:

1. Practice as an architect, an engineer or a land surveyor in this State by any person not a resident of and having no established place of business in this State, or any person resident in this State, but whose arrival in the State is recent; provided, however, such person shall have filed an application for registration as an architect, an engineer or a land surveyor and shall have paid the fee provided for in Section 9 of this Act. Such exemption shall continue for only such reasonable time as the Board requires in which to consider and grant or deny the said application for registration; and provided such person is legally qualified to practice such profession in his own state or county in which the requirements and qualifications for obtaining a certificate of registration are not lower than those specified in this Act.

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2. Practice as an architect, an engineer or a land surveyor by any person not a resident of, and having no established place of business in this State, as a consulting associate of an architect, an engineer or a land surveyor registered under the provisions of this Act; provided the non-resident is qualified for such professional service in his own State or country.
3. Practice as an architect, an engineer or a land surveyor solely as an officer or as an employee of the United States.

Sec. 14. Corporations or Partnerships May Engage in Work.—A corporation or partnership may engage in work of an architectural or engineering character, or in land surveying, in this State, provided the person or persons connected with such corporation or partnership in responsible charge of such work is or are registered as herein required of architects, engineers and land surveyors, or is or are otherwise authorized or permitted to practice as an architect, engineer or land surveyor. The same exemptions shall apply to corporations and partnerships as apply to individuals under this Act.

Sec. 15. Appeals to District Courts.—Any person aggrieved by any ruling or order of the Board made under the provisions of this Act, may appeal therefrom to any District Court of the state by serving written notice of such intention upon the secretary of the Board, specifying such court, within thirty days after the same is made. The secretary of the Board shall thereupon file with the clerk of such court a certified copy of the order or rulings or findings of fact upon which the same are based, which shall be prima facie evidence of the facts therein stated. Thereupon the court shall summarily hear and determine the questions involved on said appeal, such ruling or order of the Board shall be stayed pending the said appeal.

Sec. 16. Land Surveying Defined.—Land surveying as covered by this Act refers only to surveys for the establishment or re-establishment of land boundaries, the subdivision and platting of land and the determination of areas.

Sec. 17. Inconsistent Acts Repealed.—All laws or parts of laws in conflict with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 18. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage but registrations required hereunder by persons heretofore practicing in this state may be made at any time before July 1, 1933.

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**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

Foreword. In following these rules the Board recognizes two important requirements it must meet: first, to respect the right to his means of livelihood of the individual who has conscientiously prepared himself to practice the profession of Architecture, Engineering or Land Surveying and, second, to do what is within the power of the Board to protect the Public against dangers arising from attempts of incompetent or unscrupulous persons to practice said professions.

There shall be three classes of Registrants as follows:

- Class 1 For those who have practiced their profession not less than five years as an Architect or Engineer or four years as a Land Surveyor and are otherwise qualified under the Act.
- Class 2 For any person who holds a like certificate, unexpired, issued to him by any proper authority in any State or Territory of the United States or in any Province of Canada having registration laws where the requirements for registration are equal to those fixed by this Board and in which similar privileges are extended to holders of Certificates of Registration issued by this Board.
- Class 3 For all others than those in the foregoing classes who can show to the satisfaction of this Board they are qualified to be admitted to examination.

1. Eligibility of Applicant.

- (a) A person to be eligible for registration must be over twenty-five (25) years of age, a citizen of the United States or Canada, or who has made declaration of his intention to become a citizen of the United States; who speaks and writes the English language; who is of good moral character and repute and has been actively engaged either as an employer or an employee for five or more years in the practice of architecture or engineering, or engaged for four or more years in the practice of surveying. The character of such practice or work shall be equal to the standards fixed by the Board. Each year of teaching or of study satisfactorily completed of architecture, engineering or surveying in a school of architecture or engineering of a standard recognized by the Board shall be considered as equivalent to one year of such active engagement.
- (b) Residents of States which have registration laws will not be eligible for registration in Minnesota until they have secured registration BY EXAMINATION in the State where they reside.
- (c) The State in which the business office of the applicant is located shall determine his State of residence for the purpose of registration.
- (d) Residents of States which have no registration laws may apply for registration in Minnesota BY EXAMINATION.
- (e) Certification of an applicant's technical qualifications by the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards or the National Bureau of Engineering Registration conducted by the National Council of State Boards of Engineering Examiners, may be accepted by the Minnesota Board as establishing those qualifications and the applicant, in such instances, will not be required to pass further examination.
- (f) Any person not a resident of Minnesota is eligible for registration who holds a like unexpired certificate of registration issued to him

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by proper authority in the District of Columbia, in any State or Territory of the United States or in any Province of Canada in which the requirements for registration of Architects, Engineers or Land Surveyors are equal to those fixed by the Board for this State and in which similar privileges are extended to the holders of certificates of registration issued by this State.

CODE OF ETHICS

Technical work based upon the professional practice of Architects, Engineers and Land Surveyors has become an increasingly important factor in the progress of civilization and in the welfare of the community. These professions are held responsible for the planning, construction, and operation of such work, and are entitled to the position and authority which will enable them to discharge this responsibility and to render effective service to humanity.

That the dignity of his chosen profession may be maintained and that his obligation and responsibility to the public be impressed upon the applicant, it is required before registration is granted that each applicant subscribe to and agree to exemplify the following Code of Ethics:

- (1) To carry on his professional work in a spirit of fairness to all concerned, fidelity to clients and employers, loyalty to his country, and to be devoted to high ideals of courtesy and personal honor.
- (2) To regard as confidential any information obtained by him as to the business affairs and technical methods or processes of a client or employer.
- (3) To advertise only in a manner supporting the dignity of his profession.
- (4) To refrain from associating himself with, or allowing the use of his name in connection with, any enterprise of questionable character.
- (5) To refrain from associating, in a quasi partnership, with a person not professionally qualified or one who has not complied with the terms of the registration law, and to refrain from lending his name or seal for the approval of plans or other documents for the preparation of which he was not directly responsible.
- (6) To inform a client or employer of any business connections, interests, or affiliations which might influence his judgment or impair the disinterested quality of his services.
- (7) To accept financial or other compensation for a particular service from one source only.
- (8) To refrain from submitting competitive bids for professional services or using other improper or questionable methods of soliciting professional work.
- (9) To avoid using unfair means to win professional advancement or to injure the opportunities of another to secure or retain employment.
- (10) To discourage consulting practice by manufacturers and contractors, and endeavor to have all architectural or engineering plans, other documents, surveys and plats signed by the Architect, Engineer, or Land Surveyor directly responsible for them.
- (11) To cooperate freely with architectural and engineering agencies in advancing the architectural and engineering profession.

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- (12) To refrain from using the advantages of a salaried position in public service to compete unfairly with other Architects, Engineers, or Land Surveyors.
- (13) To confine his professional services to the branch or branches in which he is competent to practice.
- (14) To maintain interest in the public welfare and be ready to apply his special knowledge, skill, and training for the use and benefit of mankind.

2. Exemptions.

The following exemptions are permitted under Section 13 of the Act.

- (a) Practice as an Architect, an Engineer or a Land Surveyor in this State by any person not a resident of and having no established place of business in this State, or any person resident in this State but whose arrival in the State is recent; provided, however, such person shall have filed an application for registration as an Architect, an Engineer or a Land Surveyor and shall have paid the fee provided for in Section 9 of the Act. Such exemption shall continue for only such reasonable time as the Board requires in which to consider and grant or deny the said application for registration; and provided such person is legally qualified to practice such profession in his own State or Country in which the requirements and qualifications for obtaining a certificate of registration are not lower than those specified in the Act.
- (b) Practice as an Architect, an Engineer or a Land Surveyor by any person not a resident of, and having no established place of business in this State, as a consulting associate of an Architect, an Engineer or a Land Surveyor registered under the provisions of the Act, provided the non-resident is qualified for such professional service in his own State or Country.
- (c) Practice as an Architect, an Engineer or a Land Surveyor solely as an officer or as an employee of the United States.

3. Applications for Registration.

- (a) Before making formal application for examination the candidate is requested to submit to the Board, by typewritten letter, information relative to place and date of birth, time and place of schools attended and studies completed, whether he graduated or not, together with a chronological record of his employment, since completion of school work, with all dates and with complete information relative to the nature of the work performed and particularly outlining the applicant's duties in charge of the whole or any part thereof. This information will be evaluated and if the candidate is found definitely ineligible for examination at that time he will be so notified and no expense will have been incurred. If he is apparently eligible at the time for examination he will be so notified and an application form will be sent him on which to make his formal application for registration subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Board.  
A member of the Registration Board can not serve as a reference for any applicant.
- (b) Applications for registration shall be made on forms prescribed and furnished by the Board and shall be filed with the Secretary-Treasurer of the Board at St. Paul.



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- (c) Application forms will be furnished to individual applicants but will not be furnished in quantities to intermediaries.

4. Fees:

- (a) Fees shall be paid by certified check, bank draft or money order made payable to the State Board of Registration for Architects, Engineers and Land Surveyors.
- (b) The fee for examination is Ten (\$10.00) Dollars for Architects and Engineers and Five (\$5.00) Dollars for Land Surveyors, which in all instances must accompany applications. Where an applicant is apparently qualified for registration in more than one profession, the examination fee will be Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars if, in such instances, the appropriate examinations are taken at the same time. If a registrant desires registration in an additional branch of engineering subsequent to original registration it may be granted if applicant passes the examination for which the fee will be \$10.00. In the event an applicant's examination is not completed within one year next succeeding the date of the application a new application and examination fee shall be required except when a delay of more than one year is due to circumstances which, in the opinion of the Board, justify a different procedure. These fees will be retained by the Board regardless of the outcome of the examination.
- (c) The fee for registration is Ten (\$10.00) Dollars for an Architect or Engineer and Five (\$5.00) Dollars for a Land Surveyor and such payment shall be due when the application has been approved. Payment of this fee must be made prior to the issuance of the certificate of registration.
- (d) In cases where applicants are qualified for registration in two or more professions the fee therefor is Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars.
- (e) The fee for residents of other States who are eligible for registration in Minnesota is Ten (\$10.00) Dollars for Architects or Engineers, and Five (\$5.00) Dollars for Land Surveyors. The aggregate fee for registration in two or all of the three professions is Fifteen (\$15.00) Dollars.
- (f) Fees for renewal of registration are due in the month of December of each year in the amount of Three (\$3.00) Dollars for each Architect or Engineer, and One (\$1.00) Dollar for each Land Surveyor. The aggregate fee for renewal in any two or three of the professions is Three (\$3.00) Dollars.
- The renewal fees must be paid on or before December 31 of each year, otherwise the name of the Registrant will be deleted from the Roster. The postmark on the envelope containing the remittance will be accepted as the date of payment.
- (g) No fee will be charged for certifying to the qualifications of a Minnesota Registrant who applies for registration in another State. The cost of certified copies or photostats of other documents required by the State in which registration is desired shall be paid by the applicant.
- (h) The fee for renewal of registration after December 31, as fixed by the Act, is Five (\$5.00) Dollars for each Architect or Engineer, and Two (\$2.00) Dollars for each Land Surveyor. The aggregate fee for renewal in any two or three of the professions is Five (\$5.00) Dollars.

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- (1) The fee for the issuance of a new certificate to replace one revoked, lost, destroyed or mutilated is One (\$1.00) Dollar.
- (2) It is the duty of the Secretary-Treasurer to notify each registrant by mail of the date of expiration of his registration. Such notice will be sent to the address filed with the Secretary-Treasurer, and failure to receive such notice at such address shall not exempt the registrant from the penalties required by Section 9 of the Act.

5. Reciprocal Registration.

- (a) The Board may, upon application therefor and the payment of the fee required in 4 (e) above, issue a certificate of registration to any person, not a resident of Minnesota, whose qualifications are certified by the proper authorities of his own State or by the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards or the National Bureau of Engineering Registration.
- (b) The Board may, upon application therefor and the payment of a fee of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars, issue a certificate of registration to any person who holds an unexpired certificate of similar registration BY EXAMINATION, issued by the proper authority in any State or Territory or Possession of the United States, or in any Country in which the requirements for the registration of Architects, Professional Engineers or Land Surveyors are of a standard not lower than those of Minnesota; provided, however, that said States, Territories, Possessions or Countries grant full and equal reciprocal rights to registrants of this State.

Certificate of Registration.

- (1) This Board will issue to each successful Applicant a Certificate of Registration properly filled out, signed and sealed, giving the Registrant proper authority to practice the profession of Architecture, Engineering, or Land Surveying under the Registration Act of the State of Minnesota for a period ending December 31 of the year Certificate is issued, after which date the Certificate will expire unless renewed.
- (2) The Certificate of Registration is evidence of accomplishment of registration and is in force until the last calendar day of the year of issue; it may be renewed annually. (See the Act, Sec. 9)

6. Evidence of Registration—Seals.

The issuance of a certificate of registration by this Board shall be evidence that the person named therein is entitled to all rights and privileges of a Registered Architect, Registered Professional Engineer or Registered Land Surveyor while the said certificate remains unrevoked or unexpired.

Each registrant should upon registration obtain a seal of the design authorized by the Board, bearing the registrant's name and the legend "Registered Architect," "Registered Professional Engineer" or "Registered Land Surveyor." Plans, specifications, plats, reports or other documents issued by a registrant should be stamped with his seal during the life of registrant's certificate, but it shall be unlawful for anyone to stamp or seal documents with said seal after the certificate of the registrant named thereon has expired or has been revoked.

7. Rejections.

A person whose application for registration has been rejected shall be fully informed as to the reasons for the rejection. A new application, in such instances, may be filed any time after the lapse of six months next succeeding the date of the previous rejection.

8. Revocation of Registration.

(a) The Board shall have the power to revoke the certificate of registration of any Architect, Engineer or Land Surveyor registered hereunder, who is found guilty of any fraud or deceit in obtaining a certificate of registration, or of negligence, incompetency or misconduct in the practice of Architecture, Engineering or Land Surveying. Any person may prefer charges of such fraud, deceit, negligence, incompetency or misconduct against any Architect, Engineer or Land Surveyor registered hereunder. Such charges shall be in writing, sworn to by the complainant and submitted to the Board; and unless dismissed without hearing by the Board as unfounded or trivial, shall be heard and determined by the Board within three months after the date on which they are preferred. A time and place for such hearing shall be fixed by the Board. A copy of the charges, together with a notice of the time and place of hearing, shall be legally served on the accused at least thirty days before the date fixed for the hearing, and in the event that such service can not be effected thirty days before the hearing, then the date of hearing and determination shall be postponed as may be necessary to permit the carrying out of this condition. At said hearing the accused shall have the right to appear personally and by counsel, to cross-examine witnesses against him and to produce evidence and witnesses in his defense. If after said hearing five or more members of the Board vote in favor of finding the accused guilty of any fraud or deceit in obtaining a certificate, or of gross incompetency or misconduct in the practice of Architecture, Engineering or Land Surveying, the Board shall revoke the certificate of registration of the accused.

(b) The Board may reissue a revoked certificate of registration for reasons the Board may deem sufficient.

9. Violations.

(a) Any person who is not authorized to practice in this State as an Architect, an Engineer or Land Surveyor under the provisions of this Act and shall so practice, or offer so to practice, and any person presenting or attempting to file as his own the certificate of registration of another, or who shall give false or forged evidence of any kind to the Board, or to any member thereof, for the purpose of obtaining a certificate of registration, or who shall falsely impersonate any other practitioner of like or different name, or who shall use or attempt to use an expired or revoked certificate of registration, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.

(b) The Board will make every effort in its power to investigate violations of the registration Act and to secure the conviction of any and all persons guilty of such violations. Registrants are requested to inform the Board of apparent violations and to aid the Board in investigating and prosecuting such cases.

PROCEDURE IN SEEKING REGISTRATION

1. Before making formal application for examination the candidate is requested to submit to the Board, by typewritten letter, information relative to place and date of birth, time and place of schools attended and studies completed, whether he graduated or not, together with a chronological record of his employment, since completion of school work, with all dates and with complete information relative to the nature of the work performed and particularly outlining the applicant's duties in charge of the whole or any part thereof. This information will be evaluated and if the candidate is found definitely ineligible for examination at that time he will be so notified and no expense will have been incurred. If he is apparently eligible at the time for examination he will be so notified and an application form will be sent him on which to make his formal application for registration subject to the Rules and Regulations of the Board. A member of the Registration Board can not serve as a reference for any applicant.
2. When the evidence presented by an applicant for a certificate of registration shall not be conclusive or convincing as warranting the issuance of a certificate, the Board may require further evidence to be presented or may subject the applicant to such examination as may be deemed necessary to establish his qualifications.
3. In determining the qualifications of applicants for registration as Architects, a majority vote of the Architect members of the Board only shall be required; in determining the qualifications of applicants for registration as Engineers a majority vote of the Engineer members of the Board only, shall be required; and in determining the qualifications of applicants for registration as Land Surveyors the affirmative vote of the Land Surveyor member and of one Engineer of the Board only, shall be required.
4. Application forms, instructions and other information may be obtained from the Secretary-Treasurer of the Board in St. Paul. Application forms are issued only to individual applicants and will not be sent in quantities to intermediaries.
5. It is necessary for the applicant to convince the Examiners that he is qualified to practice in the field in which he seeks registration. The burden of proof is upon the applicant and he, therefore, should make every effort to present his qualifications fully and clearly. His qualifications may be established by one or more of the following methods:
  - (a) By passing a written examination. (Required from architectural applicants having less than ten years of independent practice as principal and may be required from applicants for registration as Engineers or Land Surveyors.)
  - (b) By passing an oral examination and by submitting satisfactory exhibits of his technical qualifications. (Required from Engineer and Land Surveyor applicants and from Architectural applicants having ten or more years of independent legal practice as a principal in the profession of architecture.)
  - (c) By submitting a Record prepared by the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards. (For Architectural applicants only.)
  - (d) By submitting a Certificate of Qualifications prepared by National Bureau of Engineering Registration. (For Engineering applicants only.)
6. Particular information with reference to architectural registration is given on the following pages and similar information with reference to registration of engineers and land surveyors will be found on pages 18 and 21.
7. Do not submit exhibits until requested to do so.

State Board of Registration for Architects, Engineers and Land Surveyors

REGISTRATION AS AN ARCHITECT

A person practices architecture who holds himself out as able to perform or who does perform any professional service, such as consultation, investigation, evaluation, planning, design, including aesthetic and structural design, or responsible supervision of construction, in connection with any private or public buildings, structures or projects, or the equipment or utilities thereof, or the accessories thereto, wherein the safeguarding of life, health or property is concerned or involved, when such professional service requires the application of the art and science of construction based upon the principles of mathematics, aesthetics and the physical sciences.

Written examinations shall be given under conditions as nearly like those under which an Architect works in his office as is possible. Hand books, catalogues and such other printed source of information as may be available shall be allowed the candidate for all examinations except those on History of Architecture, Architectural Composition, and Architectural Design. By virtue of the candidate's apparent eligibility to be examined it is presumed that he is well qualified in the theory of the different branches of architectural practice, and that he either has the necessary factual knowledge or knows where to find it. It remains for the examiners to learn with what ability and skill the candidate is able to apply his theoretical and factual knowledge to the various problems.

The standard Minnesota examinations are divided into two classifications, Junior and Senior. The Junior examination is for applicants who have had less than ten years of independent practice as a principal; the Senior examination is for the applicants for registration who can prove ten or more years of independent practice as an individual or as a member of a partnership or group of architects, each of whom have also had a legal practice as a principal in the profession of architecture.

To be registered in Minnesota means

- (1) That the applicant has passed a standard State examination and
- (2) That in passing Minnesota examinations he has established legal proof of distinct achievement in preparation for practice in the profession of Architecture.

The Architectural Division of the Board passes upon all applications from Architects. It is the practice of this Division to require written examinations from all applicants except

1. Applicants who have been in bona fide practice as a principal for ten or more years, and
2. Applicants who file a Record prepared by the National Council of Architectural Registration Boards, showing the applicant is registered in his home State by written (Junior) examination, or that he was registered as a Senior.

Persons registered as Architects by written examination are in a position to secure registration in other states with a minimum of inconvenience.

In the following paragraphs are given some details relative to Architectural Registration.

By Written Examination

1. This examination is open to applicants who can meet the requirements listed in the Act and the Rules of the Board.
2. The Board provides a place for the examinations and furnishes the questions, drafting board, tee square, triangles and tracing paper. The

applicant must provide drafting instruments, pencils, codes, handbooks, etc., which may be used in certain sections of the examinations.

Two examinations will be given each year at such times as may be designated by the Board. Persons who file applications for registration as an Architect, and is eligible for such registration, will be informed by letter of the date of the next examination.

3. The time limit required for the 1942 examinations and the relative importance of each part is as follows:

Division I. Qualifications and Preparation for Practice. Time—  
as required.

Examination A. Natural Aptitude and Theoretical and Practical Training. (Examinations of Applicant's Record.)

Examination B. Personal Audience (Oral Examination of Applicant.)

Division II. Structural Design and Materials..... 8 hours  
Examination C. Structural Design ..... 3 hours  
Examination D. Truss Design ..... 2 hours  
Examination E. Selection and Use of Materials..... 3 hours

Division III. Mechanical Equipment, Counselling and Administration, and Supervision..... 8 hours  
Examination F. Mechanical Equipment of Buildings..... 3 hours  
Examination G. Counselling and Administration..... 3 hours  
Examination H. Supervision ..... 2 hours

Division IV. History of Architecture and Architectural Composition ..... 8 hours  
Examination J. History of Architecture..... 4 hours  
Examination K. Architectural Composition ..... 4 hours

Division V. Architectural Design.  
Examination L. Design Problem ..... 12 hours

4. The scope of the examination is, briefly, as follows:

Division I. Personal appearance of the applicant before the examining body to obtain, by questioning and observation, basic facts not revealed in the application.

Division II. The applicant will indicate his ability to apply his theoretical knowledge of structure design to problems of practice and his skill and judgment in the use of various building materials.

Division III. The applicant may be asked questions relative to the installation and use of heating, ventilating, and air-conditioning systems: electrical equipment, water supply and sewage disposal systems, etc. There will also be a test of the applicant's judgment and ability as advisor to his clients, together with his conception of the ethical, legal, and business functions of an architect, and the knowledge and judgment of the applicant in supervising the construction of buildings.

Division IV. Demonstration of the applicant's knowledge of architecture of the past together with the principles of planning.

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Division V. The time allowed for this part of the examination is a continuous period, and it is suggested the applicant bring his lunch, or arrange to have it sent in. Use of reference material will not be permitted.

This test will indicate the applicant's understanding of the principles of architectural design and his skill in applying them to the specific problem such as might occur in practice.

5. Retakes. If an applicant fails in not more than three sections of the examination such sections shall be retaken within not less than two months or more than twelve months next succeeding the date of his application and, in any case, examination must be completed within one year next succeeding the date of the application, otherwise a new application and examination fee will be required. If failure in more than three sections of the examination occurs, the application will be considered obsolete and the applicant may file a new application and fee after the lapse of not less than twelve months next succeeding the date of previous failure.

By Exhibits

1. This type of examination is available to those persons who are graduates of an accredited school of Architecture, or the equivalent thereof, and with ten or more years of legal, independent practice as a principal, or as one of a group of principals in the profession of Architecture.
2. Employment in an Architect's office in any capacity without membership in the firm may not be counted in the required ten years of practice required for eligibility to this type of examination.
3. The following is a synopsis of the Senior examination:  
Division I. Professional Training and Record of Practice.  
Division II. Executed work including an Exhibit of Drawings, Specifications, and Photographs with a Discussion of the Architect's obligations.  
Division III. Verbal Thesis Before the Examining Body.
4. Two examinations will be given each year at such times as may be designated by the Examiners. Persons who file application for registration as an Architect, and the applicant is eligible for such registration, will be informed by letter of the date of the next examination.

REGISTRATION AS AN ENGINEER

The Engineering Division of the Board passes upon all applications from Engineers.

The Board recognizes for registration under the Act the following divisions of the profession of engineering, namely: Civil, Mechanical, Electrical, Mining, Chemical, Aeronautical, Highway, Structural, and Naval Architecture.

Applicants for registration as Engineers are required to submit exhibits of their work when they meet with the Board for the oral examination.

The following shall be considered as minimum evidence satisfactory to the Examiners that the applicant is qualified for registration: (See Section 9 of the Registration Act.)

State Board of Registration for Architects, Engineers and Land Surveyors

1. (a) Engineers—Graduation Plus Experience

Graduation from an engineering curriculum of at least four years in an accredited engineering college or school and passing an oral or oral and written examination in practical engineering design and construction, and a specific record of experience in engineering work, at least one year of which work shall meet the requirements of the Examiners for practice of engineering, and other evidence indicating that the applicant is competent to practice professional engineering, or

(b) Engineers—Non-Graduation Plus Experience

A specific record of experience in engineering work at least five years of which shall meet the requirements of the Examiners for practice of engineering, and passing an oral or oral and written examination on the fundamentals of engineering, such examination being designed to show knowledge and skill approximating that attained through graduation from a four year course in engineering design and construction, and other evidence indicating that the applicant is competent to practice professional engineering.

PRACTICE OF PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING DEFINED

The practice of professional engineering includes any professional service, such as consultation, investigation, evaluation, planning, design, responsible supervision of construction or operation, in connection with any public or private utilities, structures, buildings, machines, equipment, processes, works, or projects, wherein the public welfare, or the safeguarding of life, health or property is concerned or involved, when such professional services require the application of engineering principles and data.

It is interpreted that the practice of professional engineering does not include the work ordinarily performed by persons who operate or maintain machinery or equipment, or whose only experience has been in the execution, as a contractor, of work designed by a professional engineer or the supervision of the construction of such work as a foreman or superintendent.

Mere experience in engineering work must be distinguished from actual practice as a professional engineer. When beginning his experience, an engineer, with or without the benefit of a college education, might be engaged in activities which may or may not qualify him to practice professional engineering under an accepted definition of such practice. It is, therefore, incumbent upon the Examiners to carefully scrutinize the applicant's record, the progressive nature of the tasks performed, the responsibilities assumed, and his ethical conduct in order to determine whether or not he is qualified to assume the title of Registered Professional Engineer.

In the evaluation by the Examiners of the experience record submitted in addition to education in an accredited school, responsible charge of important work as a subordinate will be considered as qualifying experience.

The practice of professional engineering carries with it the responsible charge of work as defined in the following instances:

1. In the field, shop or laboratory, the applicant must have had the direction of work, the successful accomplishment of which rested upon him, where he had to decide questions of methods of execution and suitability of processes or materials, without relying upon advice or instruction from his superior, and of supplying deficiencies in plans or correcting errors

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- in design and processes without first referring them to higher authority for approval, except in cases where such approval is a mere matter of form.
2. In the office, the applicant must have made investigations, or carried out important assignments that demand resourcefulness and originality, or made plans, written specifications, and directed computations made in connection with engineering works when guided solely by rough sketches, general information and/or field measurements.
  3. In engineering teaching, the applicant must have taught engineering or allied scientific subjects in an accredited engineering college or school, the character of such teaching to meet the standards fixed by the Examiners.

EXAMINATION IN FUNDAMENTALS OF ENGINEERING

The purpose of this examination is to enable the Examiners to determine whether the applicant has a mastery of technical engineering fundamentals. The use of reference hand books will be permitted to the greatest extent practicable. The examination in fundamentals of engineering will include the following subjects: mathematics, including plane and solid geometry, advanced algebra, plane trigonometry, analytical and descriptive geometry, logarithms, and the elements of calculus; the more common chemical elements and chemical reactions; the elements of physics and mechanics of materials.

EXAMINATION IN PRACTICAL ENGINEERING DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION

The examination in practical engineering design and construction given for the purpose of determining proficiency in professional practice will include questions designed to show the applicant's ability to use his fundamental training and his skill in planning, designing and supervising the construction of engineering projects. The judgment and resourcefulness shown in respect to appropriateness of design for the purpose intended, relative economy, and appearance of the structure designed, will be taken into account in determining the grade. Questions may be asked to determine the applicant's knowledge of currently accepted standards of good professional practice and administration.

The written examination shall be preceded by personal appearance of the applicant before the Examiners, at which time the applicant shall be prepared to describe and discuss some project or projects with which he has been engaged as an engineer. He shall bring properly authenticated exhibits to illustrate his discussion.

The Board provides a place for the examinations and furnishes the questions, drafting board, tee square, triangles and tracing paper. The applicant must provide drafting instruments, pencils, codes, handbooks, etc., which may be used during the examinations.

Two examinations will be given each year at such times as may be designated by the Board. Persons who file applications for registration as an Engineer, and are eligible for such registration, will be informed by letter of the date of the next examination.

A NATIONAL BUREAU OF ENGINEERING REGISTRATION has been established by the National Council of State Boards of Engineering Examiners. The Secretary of the bureau is Mr. T. Keith Legare, Box 1404, Co-

lumbia, South Carolina. It is desirable that applicants from other States who wish to register in Minnesota, and Minnesota registrants wishing to register in other states, shall first secure certificates of qualifications from the National Bureau. The Minnesota Board may accept the certification of the National Bureau of Engineering Registration as satisfactory evidence of the technical qualifications of the applicant, provided the applicant shall have been registered in his own State BY EXAMINATION and provided further, that the standards of such State are not lower than those of the Minnesota Board.

REGISTRATION AS A LAND SURVEYOR

The Land Surveyor member and one Engineer member of the Board shall pass upon all applications from Land Surveyors.

1. (a) Land Surveyors—Graduation Plus Experience

Graduation from an accredited engineering college or school including the completion of an approved course of at least two years in land surveying, and a specific record of experience in land surveying at least two years of which shall be of a character meeting the requirements of the Examiners for practice of land surveying, passing an oral or oral and written examination in professional land surveying, and other evidence indicating that the applicant is competent to practice professional land surveying, or

(b) Land Surveyors—Non-Graduation Plus Experience

A specific record of experience in land surveying work, four years of which shall be of a character meeting the requirements of the Examiners for the practice of land surveying, and passing an oral or oral and written examination in the fundamental mathematics used in land surveying, and a similar examination in professional land surveying and other evidence indicating that the applicant is competent to practice professional land surveying.

PRACTICE OF PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYING DEFINED

The practice of professional land surveying applying to surveys for the establishment or re-establishment of land boundaries, the subdivision and platting of land and the determining of area shall, to be recognized by the Examiners, include correct application of:

1. A thorough knowledge of fundamental mathematics including square root, logarithms, geometry, algebra and plane trigonometry;
2. The history, principles and application of the U. S. system of public land surveys and elementary knowledge of the other systems used in the United States;
3. The United States Land Office instructions relative to the relocation of lost and obliterated corners and the subdivision of sections;
4. The legal essentials of resurveys including those involving disputed boundaries, defective deed descriptions, riparian rights and adverse possession;
5. The judicial functions of land surveyors.

EXAMINATIONS

For the purpose of determining an applicant's fitness for registration, the Examiners will consider and evaluate his qualifications under the following four classifications; fundamental education, professional practice, experience and personal elements, which latter shall include such items as personal appearance and character.

The Board provides a place for the examinations and furnishes the questions, drafting board, tee square, triangles and tracing paper. The applicant must provide drafting instruments, pencils, and may bring reference books, etc., which may be used during the examinations.

Two examinations will be given each year at such times as may be designated by the Board. Persons who file applications for registration as Land Surveyor, and are eligible for such registration, will be informed by letter of the date of the next examination.
