ordain as follows: Section 1. That the following described  
lots, No. Four, Six, Seven, Eight, Nine, Ten, Eleven, Twelve and  
Thirteen, (4, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12 and 13) Block No. Two, (2) of  
Haueter's Second (2nd) Addition to the village of Mayer, inclu-  
ding all streets and alleys adjoining and communicating therewith,  
abutting upon the incorporated village of Mayer, be and  
the same are hereby annexed to such village and shall be-  
come a part of such village as effectually as if they had  
been originally a part thereof.
