

Petition for Incorporation.

To the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Itasca and State of Minnesota;

Your petitioners recite the following facts in support of the prayer hereinafter made;

That your petitioners are more than twenty-five in number and that each of your petitioners is a voter residing within the territory hereinafter described;

That said territory is not already incorporated; that a portion of the same has been heretofore platted into lots and blocks as the "Townsite of Feeley" with a view to village occupancy and that said territory has a resident population of more than two hundred; that said plat has heretofore been duly and legally certified according to the laws of the said State of Minnesota and filed in the office of the register of deeds in and for the County of Itasca, in which said county all said lands lie;

That the unplatted part of the said territory adjoins the platted portion thereof and is so conditioned as properly to be subjected to village government;

That the territory so proposed to be incorporated as a village is as follows; certain tracts or parcels of land lying and being in the County of Itasca above named and more parti-

cularly described as follows, to-wit;

Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of County Commissioners of the County of Itasca and State of Minnesota, that said petition be, and the same hereby is, approved and granted; and

Be it further resolved that an election be held on the 26th day of April, 1911, at Woodman Hall in Section 28, Township 54 North, Range 23 West in said Itasca County, said place being within the boundaries of the territory proposed to be incorporated, for the purpose of voting upon the proposition of the incorporation of said village; that J.
