TO THE GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Dear Sir:

As Associate Justice of the Supreme Court of this State I hereby apply for retirement from that office under the terms of an act entitled "An Act to Provide for the Retirement of Justices of the Supreme Court and for Their Compensation Upon Retirement and Authorizing the Appointment of Such Retired Justices as Commissioners of the Supreme Court" (Senate File 788) enacted by the Legislature of this State at its regular 53rd Session held in the year, 1943, and approved by the Governor on April 24th, 1943.

I am past 70 years of age, having been born at Kenyon, Minnesota, on the 8 day of December, 1866, and have served continuously for over fifteen years as an Associate Justice of the Supreme Court, since the first Tuesday in January, 1928, having been appointed and elected to that office in 1928, and re-elected thereto in 1934 and 1940.

I request that you make an order directing my retirement effective May 1, 1943, under the terms of the act above referred to.

CERTIFICATE OF ADOPTION OF AMENDMENT  
TO MUNICIPAL CHARTER OF THE CITY OF  
FERGUS FALLS, OTTER TAIL COUNTY, MINNESOTA

I, the undersigned, do hereby certify that I am the duly elected, qualified and acting Mayor and Chief Magistrate of the City of Fergus Falls, Otter Tail County, Minnesota.

I do further certify that the Board of Freeholders of the City of Fergus Falls duly proposed that Section 61 of the Municipal Charter of said City be amended; that thereafter the City Council of said City duly caused the same to be submitted to the voters of said City in accordance with the constitution of the State of Minnesota and statutes relating thereto at the annual city election of said City held on the 6th day of April, 1943,

I do further certify that at the said election 864 qualified voters of said City voted at said election; that 625 ballots were cast in favor of the adoption, ratification and acceptance of said amendment; that 182 ballots were cast against the adoption, ratification and acceptance thereof; that 57 ballots were cast by voters upon which no designation was made either in favor of or against the adoption, ratification and acceptance thereof; that by reason thereof said proposed amendment was adopted, ratified and accepted by more than 3/5 of the qualified voters voting at said election.

I do further certify that thereafter and on the 8th day of April, 1943 the City Council of said City, at a special meeting duly called for such purpose and pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Charter of said City duly met and convened and canvassed the returns of the votes cast at said election and duly determined the results thereof, as hereinbefore set forth, and declared that Section 61 of the Municipal Charter of said City was amended so as to read as follows:

"The council shall appoint three freeholders of said City to act as Park Commissioners, who shall have such powers and perform such duties as the Council may designate and direct. They shall serve without compensation. The terms of office of the original three appointees shall be respectively one, two and three years. Thereafter the term of office of each shall be three years and the term of one shall expire each year, provided that no Commissioner shall serve more than two consecutive terms."
