PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, one of the most important civic duty of the people of Minnesota is the promotion of temperance and sobriety, and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the churches, civic groups and other agencies interested in the social welfare of our people should unite in a program of education concerning clean living and the building of physical well-being.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold E. Stassen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim and designate

Sunday, May 16, 1943

as

TEMPERANCE SUNDAY

and urge all the people of Minnesota to devote a portion of that day to the promotion of temperance and sobriety.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in Saint Paul this 5th day of April, 1943
