

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, pursuant to the provisions of the Selective Training and Service Act of 1940, as amended, the President of the United States has, by proclamation, designated the following dates for the Fourth Registration, with the exception of persons excepted by Section 5 (a) of the Selective Training and Service Act of 1940, as amended, and by Section 208 of the Coast Guard Auxiliary and Reserve Act of 1941:

The registration of male citizens of the United States and other male persons who shall have attained the forty-fifth anniversary of the day of their birth on or before February 16, 1942, and have not attained the sixty-fifth anniversary of the day of their birth on or before April 27, 1942, and have not heretofore been registered under the Selective Training and Service Act of 1940, as amended, and the regulations prescribed thereunder, shall take place in the United States and the Territories of Alaska and Hawaii, and in Puerto Rico, between the hours of 7:00 a. m. and 9:00 p. m. on Monday, the 27th day of April, 1942.

WHEREAS, the President of the United States has called upon the Governor of each of the several States, Territories and Puerto Rico, and the appropriate officials of the District of Columbia, and on all Local Boards and agents thereof authorized under the provisions of the Selective Training and Service Act of 1940, as amended, and upon all

officers and agents of the several States, Territories, Puerto Rico, and the District of Columbia, to do all acts and services necessary to accomplish effective and complete registration on the dates above specified.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, HAROLD E. STASSEN, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, under and by virtue of the authority vested in me by the aforesaid Selective Training and Service Act of 1940, as amended, and the regulations promulgated thereunder by the President, do hereby call upon all Local Boards and agents thereof, all officers and agents of the State of Minnesota and its political subdivisions, together with all other persons who have volunteered to act as registrars on the dates above specified, to effectively do and perform all acts and services necessary to accomplish effective and complete registration on the aforesaid dates.

I do further ask that the flag be displayed on registration day on all public buildings and all private buildings and homes and that all public and private business institutions of the State give employees who are required to register, the necessary time from their duties to fulfill the important obligations of registration incumbent upon them under the Selective Training and Service Act of 1940, as amended, the

Proclamation of the President of the United States, and their duty as fortunate citizens of, and residents of, the United States of America.
