

PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, there is a critical need in war production for iron, steel, aluminum, tin, copper and copper base alloys, and

WHEREAS, our government has asked us to collect more than a half million tons of scrap metal in Minnesota before July 1st, and

WHEREAS, our state is lagging in the tin can, kitchen fat and scrap metal collections,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDWARD J. THYE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the months of

MAY AND JUNE

AS

SALVAGE DRIVE MONTHS

and urgently appeal to industry and agriculture especially, to scrap obsolete equipment, and to all Minnesotans generally, to get behind this drive and give every bit of these materials they can which are not being used and cannot be restored to use.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Hinnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol in Saint Paul this 5th day of May, 1943.
