WHEREAS, a petition, signed by Joseph Doncaster and twenty-three others, male freeholders who are legal voters in the town of Clover, County of Pine, which said town embraces more than two Congressional townships, was presented to the Board of County Commissioners of said County, at a meeting of said Board held on the 27th day of March, 1911, asking for the formation of a new town in accordance with Section 452, Revised Laws of 1905, out of part of the territory now included in the town of Clover, viz; - All of Township Forty-one (41), North Range Nineteen (19) West, in the County of Pine and State of Minnesota.

WHEREAS, it was then ordered, that the 15th day of May, 1911, be fixed as the day of hearing on said petition, and that Notice of said hearing on said petition, be posted and served as required by Section 455, Revised Laws of Minnesota of 1905.

AND WHEREAS, it appears from the certificate of W.H. Hamlin, County Auditor, and the affidavit of C.B. Brown, now before us, that the said Notice has been duly posted and served as required by law,

NOW THEREFORE, after duly considering such petition, and hearing all reasons offered for or against the granting of said petition, and being satisfied that the public interest will be subserved by the formation of said new town, and that its formation in manner and form as asked for in the said petition will be best adapted to the proper transaction of public business; -


IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that the following described territory, to wit; - All of Township Forty-one (41) North, Range Nineteen (19) West, in Pine County, State of Minnesota, be, and hereby is formed and organized as a new town, to be known as the Town of ARLONE, and that the exterior boundary lines of said Township 41, Range 19, shall be the boundaries of said new town of Arlone.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the time and place for holding the first Town Meeting be fixed for Monday, the 29th day of May, 1911 at the Turpville School house in said township, and the County Auditor is hereby directed to have the Notices of said meeting posted and served as required by law.
