WHEREAS, the tax delinquency in and for the township of Shovel Lake, township 52, range 27, Aitkin County, Minnesota, for the year of 1941, was and still is, more than 60% of the taxes levied in said town of Shovel Lake, Aitkin County, Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, the town government of said town of Shovel Lake, Aitkin County, Minnesota, appears to be the Board of County Commissioners of said Aitkin County, Minnesota, to be unable to function as a town government, by reason of lack of funds and credit, and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Board of County Commissioners of Aitkin County, Minnesota, that it is advisable to have the town organization of said town of Shovel Lake dissolved,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the town of Shovel Lake, township 52, range 27, Aitkin County, Minnesota, be and the same hereby is dissolved, and that the territory formerly comprising said town of Shovel Lake, Aitkin County, Minnesota, be henceforth governed as unorganized territory of said Aitkin County, Minnesota.

Commissioner Simpson moved the adoption of the resolution and it was declared adopted upon the following vote: All commissioners voting "Aye".
