COLLINS, as Special Assistant Attorney General, to act for the Minnesota State Agricultural Society during the 1943 Minnesota State Fair, to be held August 28 to September 6, 1943, and for such time as may be necessary to act at that place, either before or after said fair, action to be taken in all matters that require the immediate attention as an adviser to the State Agricultural Society or of a prosecuting attorney.

This appointment is made upon recommendation of the Governing Board of the Minnesota State Fair and upon my judgment that the public welfare will be promoted thereby. I hereby fix his compensation at One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150) to be paid from and out of the appropriation made for the Minnesota State Agricultural Society.
