PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, there exists in our country today an extreme shortage of pulpwood from which paper and vital war materials are being manufactured and because of the heavy demands on wood for substitute war materials from which tin, rubber, aluminum, and steel are also manufactured, and

WHEREAS, The Department of Agriculture, the Office of Price Administrator, the War Manpower Commission, the War Production Board, Office of Defense Transportation, and the Federal Government have asked the newspapers of the nation to handle this drive as they did the scrap drive, and

WHEREAS, the forest products industry is one of the largest in our state and the pulpwood shortage threatens the shutdown of these industries,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, EDWARD J. THYE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, appeal to all woodlot farmers and producers of Minnesota to lend all support to this drive in cutting more pulpwood this season to keep the vital war materials moving and to continue the prosperity of our state.
