PROCLAMATION.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter Seven (7) Revised Laws of Minnesota, 1905, a petition was filed with the Secretary of State on the tenth day of November, 1910, praying for the creation of a new county out of the territory now lying in Polk County, Minnesota, the same to be known as Columbia County, and described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the Southwest (SW) corner of Township One Hundred Forty-Seven (147) North, of Range Forty-Three (43) West, thence running North along the Range line between Ranges Forty-Three (43) and Forty-Four (44) West, to the Northwest (NW) corner of Township One Hundred Forty-Nine (149) North, of Range Forty-Three (43) West; Thence running East along the Township line to the Southwest (SW) corner of Township One Hundred Fifty (150) North, of Range Forty (40) West; Thence North along the Township line to the Northwest (NW) corner of said Township One Hundred Fifty (150) North, of Range Forty (40) West; Thence East along the Township line to the Northeast (NE) corner of Township One Hundred Fifty (150) North, of Range Forty (40) West; Thence North along the Township line to the Northwest (NW) corner of Township One Hundred Fifty-One (151) North, of Range Thirty-Nine (39) West; Thence East along the Township line to the Northeast (NE) corner of said Township One Hundred Fifty-One (151) North, of Range Thirty-Nine (39) West; Thence South along the Range line between Ranges Thirty-Eight (38) and Thirty-Nine (39) West, to the Southeast (SE) corner of Township One Hundred Forty-Seven (147) North, of Range Thirty-Nine (39) West; Thence West along the Township line to the place of beginning; All West of the Fifth Principal Meridian; that

be the Village of McIntosh; and that

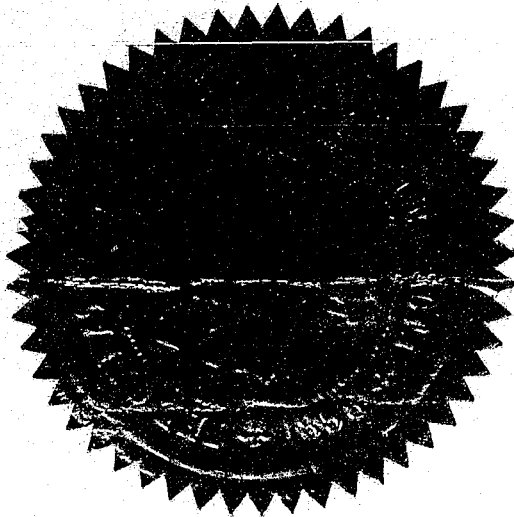
F. E. LePage of the Village of Mentor, Ed. S. Erickson of the Town of Chester, Andrew J. Higden of the Town of Sletten, E. L. Hanson of the Town of Hill River, and Chas. McCarty of the Town of King, all in said county, be and constitute the first Board of County Commissioners of said proposed county; and

WHEREAS, the said petition has been duly considered and found and certified to as conforming in all respects to the provisions of law;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Adolph O. Eberhart, governor of the State of Minnesota, pursuant to the authority vested in me by law, do hereby direct and proclaim that the question of the creation of the proposed new county of Columbia be submitted to the voters of said Polk County at the next general election to be held in this state on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November, 1912.
