month in Minnesota and urge every citizen to acquaint himself thoroughly with the production of food, how it fights with our armed men, our allies, the liberated peoples, and civilians on the Home Front, and how it is allocated among these groups and why; how our supply is affected by increased purchasing power; why rationing and price control are essential; how much we waste; where and why we must conserve, and why adjustments in our food habits and thinking have become a war time necessity.
